

## Description of Walks – Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> March 2026

Start Time	Walk	Description	Meeting Point and Registration
9:00 am	Grevillea Lookout	A 5 -6 km walk starting on corner of Camp Link Rd and Mount Cole Rd towards Cave Hill Creek Track following part of Beeripmo circuit in the Mount Cole State Forest. Rating: <b>Grade 3</b> —hilly terrain approx. <b>2 hours. Very limited parking – car pooling advised</b>	Beaufort Community Bank Complex Meet for car-pooling to start point.
9.00 am	Waterloo State Forest – nature based	A 15km walk through Waterloo State Forest. Commencing at the Waterloo cemetery and including the heritage listed alluvial gold site of Baxter Gully. Rating: <b>Grade 3/4</b> — hilly terrain Walk duration: <b>approx. 4.5 hours.</b>	Beaufort Community Bank Complex. Meet at 8.30am sharp for car-pooling.
9.30 am	Stephen Track/Camp Hill/Musical Gully Circuit	4.3 km, taking approx. 1h 15 min. Undulating, shady track past gold digging areas with some steeper inclines. Two viewpoints at around 500m above sea level Grade 2/3	Beaufort Community Bank Complex Car-pooling
10 am	Cemetery Walk and Yam Holes	A 4 km walk with pauses for commentary. Rating: Grade 2 duration: approx. 2 hours	Beaufort Community Bank Complex
10 am	Lake and Trawalla State Forest Walk	A 9km walk that uses the board walk to cross the lakebed and then goes up Mopoke Gully Lane to Trawalla State Forest for a loop through the bush. Rating: <b>Grade 3</b> - There are some steep climbs when it crosses gullies. Walk duration: <b>approx. 2.5 hours</b>	Beaufort Community Bank Complex

2 pm	History and Town Circuit Walk	An easy walk with frequent pauses to learn about the history of Beaufort. Approx. 1 km. Rating: <b>Grade 2</b> Duration: <b>approx. 1.5 hours</b>	Beaufort Band Rotunda
2 pm	Wheelie Walk	Enjoy a short wheelie walk around Beaufort town centre followed by FREE afternoon tea at the Library Ideal for people in wheelchairs and walkers, and their companions.	Entrance Beaufort Hospital
1.30 pm	Mining Relics Walk	A guided walk exploring the history of mining in the Main Lead area. Rating: Hard , uneven ground. Walk duration: approx. 3.5 hours. Please pre-register for this walk as numbers are capped at 10. <b>Grade 4 (less than 5km but due to uneven ground and no marked path).</b>	Beaufort Community Bank Complex Meet at 1.30pm sharp for car-pool to start
